Patch. Each patch cost \$3.00, which includes shipping to your doorstep. Send your check to Mike Brian.

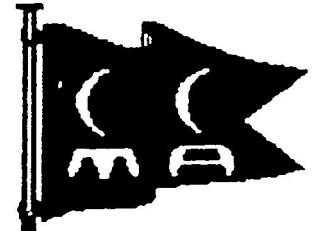

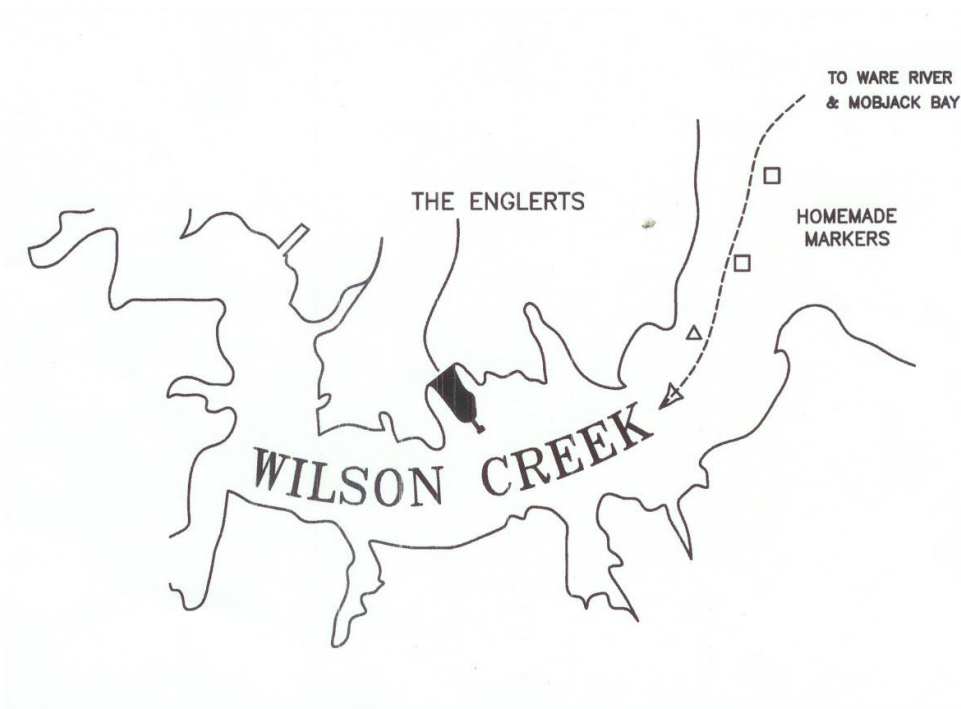
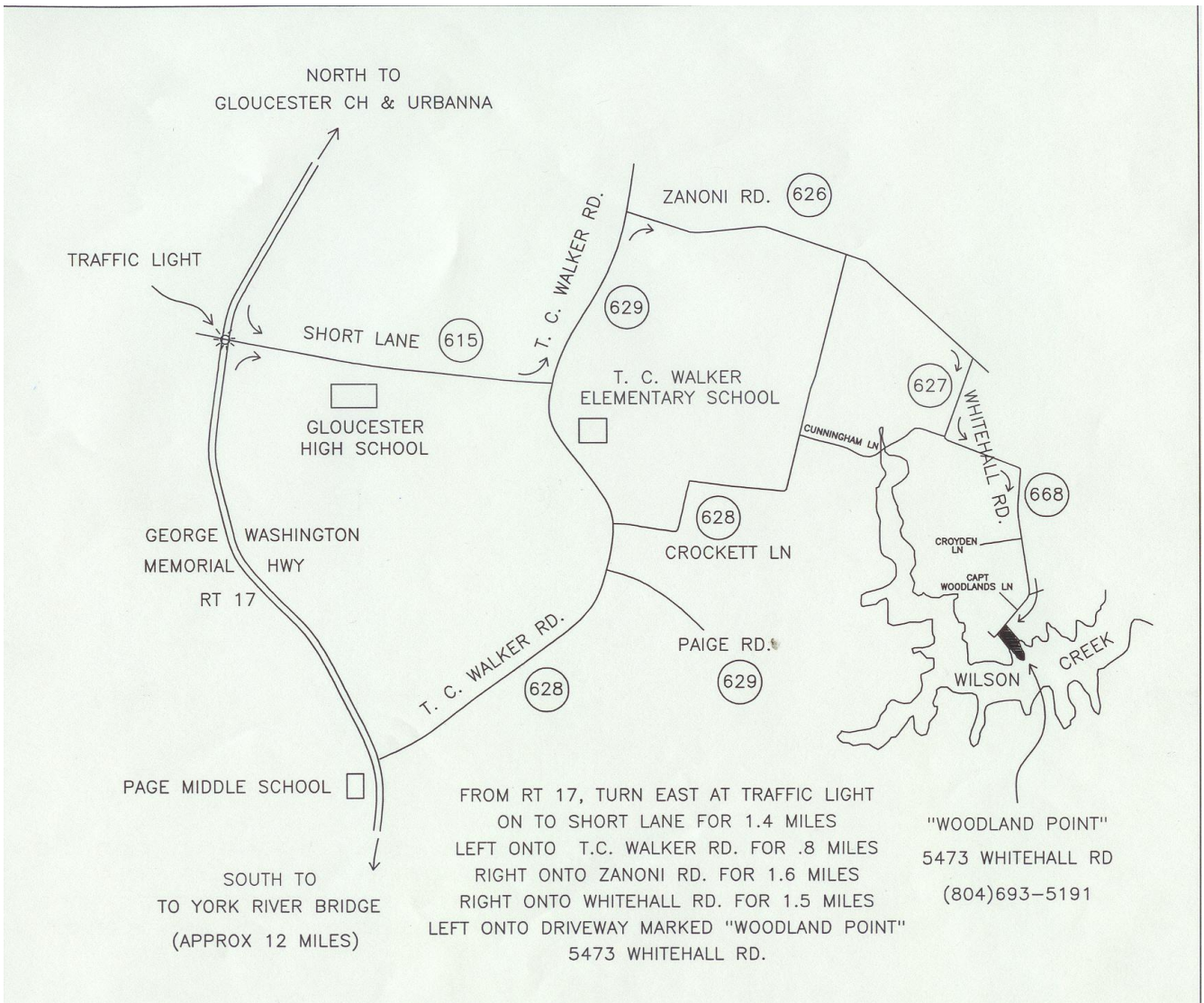
